If the Dual Head Stethoscope is not properly assembled and installed, personal injury and damage to the Stethoscope could result.

UNPACKING

Carefully remove all components (see next page) from carton and inspect. If components are damaged or missing, do not use product, and contact your Graham-Field authorized distributor immediately.

INTENDED USE

The stethoscope is intended to facilitate the ability to hear internal sounds.


FEATURES

- Anodized aluminum rotating chestpiece with recessed non-chill ring
- Adjustable aluminum binaural to ensure a comfortable, acoustically sealed aural fit
- 22" latex-free Y-tubing
- White firm threaded PVC eartips



Components included:

Stethoscope with rotating chestpiece, tubing, binaural, and one set of eartips, as shown at right.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Adjusting the Binaural Tension

▲ NOTICE: The binaural only needs to be adjusted slightly — DO NOT squeeze or pull excessively.

To tighten the binaural, hold it at the base, at the bottom of the "Y", as shown at center right. Squeeze together gently until the eartips cross and the desired tension is achieved.

To loosen the binaural, grasp it with both hands above the "Y", as shown at lower right. Pull binaural apart gently until the desired tension is achieved.



Increase binaural tension (tighten)



Decrease binaural tension (loosen)



OPERATION

This dual-headed stethoscope, equipped with both large and small diaphragms fitted on a revolvable twin drum, is operational in two positions 180° apart. The drum contains a leak-free valve stem.

- 1. Carefully insert binaural eartips into ears.
- 2. Tap the diaphragm softly; this should produce sounds clearly. If you don't hear the tapping sound, rotate the head 180° until it clicks into place in the other operational position.
- 3. Tap again to be sure the instrument is correctly set for use.
- 4. Follow the same procedure when you convert from one chestpiece to another.

CARE, MAINTENANCE, AND CLEANING

- ▲ NOTICE: DO NOT subject the stethoscope to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
- ▲ NOTICE: DO NOT immerse in liquid, sterilize, or apply solvent or oil to the stethoscope.

To ensure the sound quality of your stethoscope:

Wipe stethoscope with a clean, soft, nonabrasive cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution, then dry with a clean, soft, nonabrasive cloth. Clean stethoscope thoroughly before each use. If disinfection is required, wipe the stethoscope with a 70% isopropyl alcohol solution.

Remove and clean eartips as needed with a damp cloth to prevent excessive cerumen or other foreign matter from entering the eartips and tubing. To remove, grasp eartips firmly and unscrew them from binaurals. Reinstall eartips immediately after cleaning.

LIMITED WARRANTY

SCOPE OF WARRANTY

The warranted components and time periods are set forth below:

Stethoscope: 1 (one) year

Labor is not included in the warranty.

‡The warranty period is as designated above. If a part is replaced under warranty, the original warranty period will not be affected. All other replacement parts will be subject to the warranty period specified. The applicable warranty period shall commence from date of shipment to the original customer, unless there is an expiration date on the component in which case the warranty shall expire on the earlier of warranty period or the expiration date.

OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE

Customers located outside the United States must contact the Distributor from whom they purchased the products. In both cases, further directions will be provided once the initial contact is made. This limited warranty shall only apply to defects that are reported within the applicable warranty period. Failure to abide by the specific directions will result in denial of the warranty claim.

The warranty does not cover and GF shall not be liable for the following:

- Defects, damage, or other conditions caused, in whole or in part, by misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, accident, freight damage, tampering or failure to seek and obtain repair or replacement in a timely manner;
- Products which are not installed, used, or properly cleaned and maintained as required in the official manual for the 2) applicable product;
